Documentation of Paid Field Hours

The certification program requires candidates to be prepared to document 600 (CPC) or 1600 (A-CPC) field hours to meet the experience requirement. Field hours must be from the past two years for CPC candidates and from the past three years for A-CPC candidates. Although you might not bill your client by the hour, the certification program requires candidates to document hours (not services or number of clients).

The certification program requires candidates to affirm that they have met the field hour requirements on the application. A <u>form</u> is available to assist you in logging your hours. The form is for your use only and will not be submitted with your certification application. Great record keeping will assist you if your application is audited. The privacy of clients and candidates will be considered a high priority for audits.

*Candidates may earn a maximum of 100 points of credit towards the required 600 or 1600 paid field experience hours for other safety-related services/experience. Please review <u>Substitute Field</u><u>Hours</u>.
